From September you will find that there will be far more for you to look at in terms of what the children are doing.






FSM VOUCHERS: Free School Meal vouchers for those children that qualify are again available over the summer. Please check your emails from the first week of the holidays.

<u>SCHOOL DAY CONSULTATION</u>: Thank you for the many responses to the school day consultation. Having reviewed all responses, I can confirm that from September, the school day will begin at 8.45 and will end at 3.15. For now, Breakfast Club will continue to run from 8.15am but we will review this. Breakfast Club will remain free of charge.

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY: Attached to class dojo is our renewed school uniform policy. We have tried to strike a balance of keeping the children smart and ensuring expenses for parents are kept to a minimum. The main changes are as follows:

- Children are not required to have the school badge of their uniform
- Shoes should be black and appropriate for school
- Joggers are not a part of our school uniform
- Jewellery should not be worn
- Children attend in PE clothes only on PE days
